

# SIAMG Fellowship in Clinical Molecular Genetics

## CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

Society for Indian Academy of Medical Genetics, in association with Centre for DNA Fingerprinting and Diagnostics, Hyderabad, has launched an 18 month fellowship program for training in CLINICAL MOLECULAR GENETICS

The program will provide the trainee with competence in the application of molecular biology principles to modern medical practice and relevant research experience. At the end of training, the individual is expected to possess the knowledge, skills and attitudes necessary to 1) supervise and direct the operations of a clinical molecular genetic diagnostic laboratory 2) diagnose and interpret a wide range of DNA abnormalities, and 3) appropriately communicate molecular genetic laboratory results and interpretations as a consultant to referring clinicians.

### Program duration

Eighteen months, full time

### Eligibility

The candidate must have a postgraduate degree (MD/DNB) in Pathology/ Microbiology/ Biochemistry/Anatomy/Physiology.

### Intake (Number of students)

One per calendar year

### Mode of selection

Written/Computer based entrance examination followed by Interview by a selection committee

### Award Support:

The fellow will be paid stipend for the duration of fellowship as per CDFD rules. No accommodation will be provided.

### Fellowship Schedule:

Fellowship starts: 1<sup>st</sup> September 2016

Last date for submission of applications: 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2016 (By Post/Email with relevant photocopies of educational qualifications/experience etc. Incomplete applications will not be considered)

Shortlisted candidates will be informed by 5<sup>th</sup> July 2016

Date of Entrance examination: 21<sup>st</sup> July 2016
